"Northern 54 Series"

If you've ever wondered about flying in competitions but have been put off by the prospect then the following is for you. Unlike most competitions this will be a low pressure comp aimed at lower airtime pilots. A fun comp in all senses. It's a great opportunity to broaden your flying experience by flying sites you may not have previously thought of flying (sites that you are eligible to fly under our reciprocal agreement with neighbouring clubs) and by flying with more experienced pilots (but not so experienced they disappear with the first thermal and leave you wondering where they went)!

Personally, I put off flying in comps because I didn't like flying in 'gaggles'. Once I started I found it was actually ok but if there had been something similar to this competition I would have given it a go much earlier.

A brand new competition is being launched this year the "Northern 54 Series". This will be an entry level competition for Pilots and Club Pilots with ten or more hour's airtime. It is the intention to provide two tasks, one more difficult than the other; so that the experienced pilots can help lower airtime pilots achieve the first task, before tackling the second themselves. This should provide a coaching environment whilst still presenting a challenge suitable for all.

Safety will be the overriding consideration when setting the tasks. The Dales club and our neighbouring clubs will hold one round each, held over a weekend, with camping and socialising as well as the flying.

The NHPC have offered to open the **Northern 54 Series** with a comp at one of our best sites, Cross Fell on the Pennine range of hills, just east of Penrith.

As we have opted for a site, rather than a date, we have said that we will hold the comp on the first suitable weekend in May. We will put the comp onto 'Amber Alert' for the weekend on a Wednesday evening, updating the alert as we get closer to the weekend.

Hopefully that way we can have a good comp without any wasted journeys, however, we guarantee nothing!!!

There is a good camp site opposite a pub who have promised me they will fit us all in, 'somewhere'.

There are a few sensitive issues with the site, mainly with walkers who complain that we use the track up the hill with 4x4s and parking

in the village of Kirkland which is quite restricted.

To minimise the effect of the comp on these issues the farmer is going to provide us with a field opposite the church on the approach to Kirkland. I am asking for a contribution of £1 per pilot to give to the farmer for his good will. We will try to provide transport for the wings to take off, or at least ¾ of the way up, depending on the condition of the track.

JUST ONE DAY - AND YOU WILL BE BETTER EQUIPPED TO DEAL WITH ACCIDENTS AND PERHAPS SAVE A LIFE Wales sites again this year, by kind permission of the 3 clubs. It is open to all pilots rated CP(H) and above. Non CP rated pilots are welcome to compete in the Novice competition but they must be accompanied and supervised by their own instructor. Come along and enjoy a weekend's flying at sites you may not normally fly, in a safe and friendly atmosphere. Transport to the top is provided by the organisers, but remember numbers are limited to 60 so get your entry in early. The entry fees are £35 if entry is received by Friday 28th May or £45 if received after.

Location: The Royal Hill pub, Edgerley,

Shropshire. Camping fees have increased to £2.50/person/night this year. The contact number for The Royal Hill is 01743 741242, but for those arriving on Friday (after 1400) or Saturday there is no need to contact the pub to arrange a pitch as the camping field has been booked for the competition.

Anybody wishing to arrive before the Friday should contact the Royal Hill directly to arrange a pitch or contact Chris Haynes on 07973 166456.

Registration will be at the campsite next to the Royal Hill pub between 1800 and 2200 on Friday 4th June and between 0700 and 0800 on Saturday 5th June. There will be a briefing for competitors at the campsite at 0830 on Saturday and Sunday.

Carlton on Sunday


Does anybody know the pilot who landed in the fields below Carlton on Sunday?
